Noel S. V. Omega is a serial entrepreneur and investor who started out as an information technology professional in 1979. He has appeared in the public eye since 1980 as a professional emcee, community leader, public relations spokesperson for various socio-civic interests, business & industry subject matter expert and an outspoken advocate for public policy, fiscal common sense and limited government bureaucracy. Noel currently serves as the Chairman for the National Federation of Filipino American Associations (NaFFAA) Region 9 Greater Los Angeles Region representing an estimated 600,000+ Filipinos and Filipino-Americans and 700+ Associations in the Southern California Area.

Noel refocused his career into business initiatives in 2000 after leaving the corporate world. Noel joined the San Fernando Valley Filipino-American Chamber of Commerce (SFVFACC) in 2003 and became its P.R.O. Elected as the chamber president in 2005, he incorporated SFVFACC and established its charter beyond the San Fernando Valley. This culminated in the Filipino-American Chamber of Commerce of Greater Los Angeles (FACC-GLA) in 2011. Noel's passion for Filipino-American economic empowerment helped facilitate the establishment of various Filipino-American Chambers of Commerce in the greater L.A. area, most notably the FACC-SouthBay L.A. Area (2011) and the FACC-Tri-County (L.A., San Bernardino and Riverside in 2014). Noel continues to champion economic empowerment by working with various Filipino-American population centers in the greater L.A. area and engaging the youth to promote economic empowerment literacy.

Noel served as the Grand Chairman for the 2008 Philippine Independence Day Celebrations in Los Angeles and continues to serve as ex-officio board member of Kalayaan, Inc. Noel's community involvement includes leadership capacities with various organizations including the Federation of Philippine American Chambers of Commerce/FPACC (Vice President of National Conference, 2012-2013, which brought about the record setting FPACC Bi-National Convention 2013 in Los Angeles), Jose P. Rizal Monument Movement (Board Member), Los Angeles Mission College Foundation (Board Member 2008-2010), Valley Voters Organized Toward Empowerment/ Valley VOTE (Board Member 2002-2009), Los Angeles Brilliant Lions Club (Vice President), Knights of Columbus Council 14772 (Charter Deputy Grand Knight), Mabuhay Toastmasters (Charter Co-founder) as well as various other community and civic organizations.

Noel advocates ethical and responsible business ownership, maintains a visible profile with the local media and proactively engages all levels of government to help promote equitable public policy, leadership accountability, fiscal responsibility, local control and developing viable economic alternatives through free enterprise.
